Fields of Grace 2011

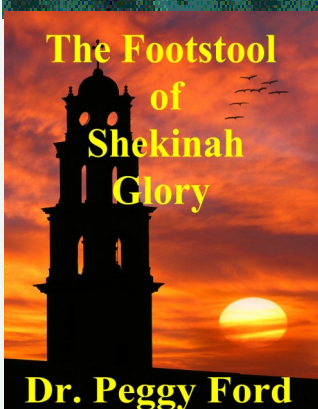
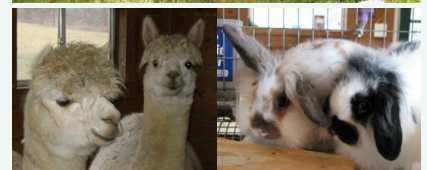

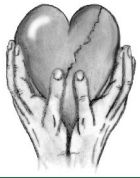


Dr. Peggy Ford's Second Book Published

The ministry has partnered with Interfaith over ten years to help organize the Christmas project, which provides toys and a food basket for families in need in Susquehanna County. Many churches, businesses, and organizations donated the toys and food. The program assisted five hundred and forty-eight families, who may have lost their jobs, or endured serious illnesses, or many lost all their possessions during the flood. In addition, thirty seven families were adopted for a larger blessing of extra special gifts, such as household needs, clothing, and small appliances.
